AGREEMENT ON ACADEMIC EXCHANGE BETWEEN

THE HUMAN INTERFACE TECHNOLOGY LAB NEW ZEALAND (HIT Lab NZ) AND

CYBERMEDIA CENTER, OSAKA UNIVERSITY

The Director of the Human Interface Technology Lab New Zealand (HIT Lab NZ), New Zealand, and the Director of Cybermedia Center, Osaka University, Japan, with the objective of promoting cooperation in the fields of education and academic research, agree to conclude the following agreement on academic exchange.

Article 1. Both parties agree to promote the following activities so as to enhance their institutions' educational and academic roles:

- (1) Activities such as collaborative research, lectures, symposiums, etc., and exchange of scholars and researchers pertaining thereto;
- (2) Exchange of information and materials in those fields which are of interest to both parties;
- (3) Exchange of research students.

Article 2. Details of the implementation of any particular exchange resulting from this agreement shall be negotiated and agreed upon between the two parties as such specific cases arise.

Article 3. This agreement shall become effective on the date of its signing by the representative of both parties and shall be in force for five years. Either party may, by giving six months' written notice to the other party, terminate this agreement. In the absence of such an early termination, the renewal of this agreement shall be discussed by the two parties no less than six months prior to the natural termination of current agreement.

Article 4. This agreement is to executed in English and Japanese, with all two versions equally authentic, and each party will retain a copy of each version.
